Highlights:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 108 surveys completed of Non-virally Suppressed participants • 50 surveys being completed for Virally Suppressed clients • Race/ethnicity, gender and exposure category (MSM, IDU, both) are reflective when comparing the 2017 Epi profile to the survey results. <p>Participant characteristics:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 33% report NEVER having been tested for HIV before positive test • 52% report education level at high school/GED or below • 3% report CURRENT gender as transgender • 21% report not employed, looking for work • 80% report income of \$24,999 or below <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 56% report income below \$9,999 • 27% report waiting more than a year to access HIV medical care • 35% report no insurance • Oldest survey respondent: 72; youngest 27 <p>Viral Load Undetectable: 41% report no Reasons why your viral load is not undetectable:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Newly Diagnosed • Out of Care 	No Action Necessary.	

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Forgot • Other co-morbidity (Depression/Substance Use) • Medicine makes me sick • Homeless <p>The Committee reviewed Jeff Daniel's updated preliminary findings and no further action was needed. Jeff Daniel has distributed surveys and gift cards to a local agency to conduct interviews on youth 18-24, women and recently released from incarceration. The Committee will await for final presentation and results in June 2018.</p> <p>The Committee discussed target groups for the upcoming Comprehensive Needs Assessment being conducted in the Fall 2018, to include Youth 18-24, Substance Abusers, Homeless and Women.</p>
